

Data privacy

The protection of personal data privacy during the collection, processing and use of your data on the occasion of your visit to our home page is an important concern to us. Your data shall be protected within the scope of statutory regulations. In the following paragraphs you will find information as to which data will be captured during your visit to our home page and how these will be used:

1. Collection and processing of data

Each access to our home page and each retrieval of a file stored on our home page will be logged. Data will be stored for internal, system-related and statistical purposes. The following will be logged: name of the retrieved file, date and time of retrieval, transmitted data volume, notification of successful retrieval, web browser and requesting domain. In addition, the IP addresses of the enquiring computers will be logged. Any additional personal data will only be logged if you specify these details voluntarily, for example within the scope of an enquiry or registration.

2. Use and dissemination of personal data

If you have provided us with personal data, we shall only use these data to reply to your enquiries, to process contracts we have concluded with you and for technical administration purposes. Your personal data shall only be transmitted to third parties or otherwise, if this proves necessary for the purpose of contract processing - in particular the transmission of order data to suppliers - or if this is necessary for billing purposes or if you have agreed to this beforehand. You are entitled to revoke your agreement at any time with future effect. Stored personal data shall be deleted if you revoke your consent to data storage, if it is no longer necessary to know these data to meet the purpose for which their storage was intended or if their storage is illegal for other legal reasons.

3. Right of access to personal data

At your written request, we shall gladly provide you with information on your stored personal data.

We endeavour to store your personal data such that they are inaccessible for third parties by making use of any available technical and organisational means. However, when communicating via e-mail, we cannot guarantee complete data privacy, which is why we recommend sending confidential information by post.
